Egg-citing Bouncy Egg

Materials:

- Raw egg
- White Vinegar
- Clear jar
- Food Dye (if wanted)



Instructions:

- 1) **Place egg the jar**
Gently put the egg into a clear jar with a **wide opening**. (The egg will expand with time, so a wide opening is important)
- 2) **Add the vinegar**
Pour vinegar into the jar until the egg is completely covered.
★ **Fun idea:** Add a few drops of food coloring to the vinegar to make your **colorful bouncy egg!**
- 3) **Watch what happens**
Look closely! Do you see bubbles forming on the shell? What do you think is happening?
- 4) **Wait and check**
Leave the egg in the vinegar for about **2 days**. When the shell is gone, carefully rinse the egg with warm water. You'll notice a **soft, stretchy layer** around the egg
- 5) **Test the bounce**
Gently drop the egg from a small height and see if it **bounces**. How high can it go without breaking?
