Fireworks in a Jar

You'll need:

- A clear jar or glass
- Warm water
- 2-3 tbsp. of vegetable oil
- Red and blue food coloring
- Bowl and a spoon



Instructions:

1. Fill your jar about $\frac{3}{4}$ full with warm water
2. Pour the vegetable oil into a small bowl
3. Add several drops of red and blue food coloring to the oil
4. Give it a gentle stir and then carefully pour the mixture into the jar
5. Get ready for the show! Watch the colors sink and burst like tiny fireworks in the sky!!

☆ **Tip:** Try adding white paper behind the jar to make your fireworks shine even brighter!
