Apple Volcanoes

Materials:

- 1 apple
- Baking soda
- Vinegar
- Knife (for adults to use)
- Food coloring
- Spoon



Directions:

1. Have an adult carefully cut a hole in the top of the apple, about halfway down.
2. Fill the hole with about 3 spoonfuls of baking soda.
3. Add a few drops of food coloring to the baking soda for a colorful eruption
4. Slowly pour vinegar into the hole and watch your apple volcano fizz, bubble, and erupt!
